School Health Advisory Council

Meeting Minutes November 16, 2017

Opening:

The School Health Advisory Council (SHAC) meeting was called to order at 12:25p.m. on November 16, 2017 in the Media Center of Lewis Chapel Middle School by Ms. Angela Hurley.

Welcome: Angela Hurley opened the meeting by greeting everyone and thanking them for coming to our second SHAC meeting for the 2017-2018 school year.

A. Dental Screening Visits

Wendy Seymore, a dental hygienist from the state dental program presented a free dental screening program for Cumberland County Schools. The goal of this program is to screen students in efforts to monitor for dental carries and disease. The screening is used to detect untreated and treated decay, dental sealants on permanent molars, and urgency of need for dental treatment. The data collected will be taken to the state to request funding for preventative services and dental programs. If approved, the screening will be performed on kindergarten students every year and 3rd-grade students every other year in four or five randomly selected schools. The schools are selected based on socioeconomic needs in the school population. Ms. Johnson requested additional information such as other LEA's who have participated in this program be provided and discussed during our next SHAC meeting.

Dental Health Education presentations for middle and high schools are available as well as school-based clinics for week long sealant programs are free for high risk schools.

B. Wonder Years

Shirley Johnson briefly spoke about the Wonder Years curriculum for 4th and 5th-grade students. Due to low numbers in attendance, the discussion was tabled until the next SHAC meeting.
